School Responsibilities

Frankfort Intermediate School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the state's student academic achievement standards as follows:

 - WESTEST reports to parents (sent at beginning of school year)

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.
 - Parents are welcome to make an appointment for consultation with the staff.
 - Staff will make every reasonable effort to accommodate parents' needs.
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:
 - Volunteering for the PTO
 - Participation in school activities and events (ex. Book Fairs, Classroom Helpers, Reading Tutors, Library, Disney Day, ect.)
 - You may also eat lunch with your child at school. Please inform the office in advance if you will be purchasing a school lunch.
 - Observing a class – we may invite you to join us or you may request to visit.
